Health & Safety

Heatwave

Hot weather has been predicted for this summer (hooray) and with it, Public Health England has issued guidelines on keeping children safe in hot weather. Here are a few guidelines:



- Children should not engage in vigorous physical activity on very hot days i.e. in temperatures in excess of 30oC
- Encourage children to play in the shade
- Clothing should be light coloured and loose and wear wide brimmed sun hats
- Use sunscreen (at least factor 15 with UVA protection) to protect their skin
- Provide children with plenty of cold water and encourage them to drink more than usual.
